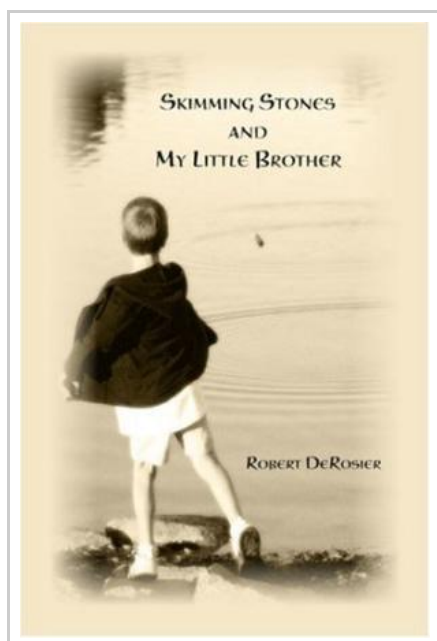




Skimming Stones and My Little Brother
