

THROMBOSIS (derived from the Greek thrombos, a clot of blood) is a term originally suggested by Virchow, and was generally employed to designate an affection of the blood-vessel, (either veins or arteries) which essentially consists in a coagulation of blood (forming a true clot) at a certain fixed spot. Under certain morbid conditions, the blood has a tendency to coagulate in its vessels during life, on the least provocation. Thus, slight pressure on the side of the vein will sometimes induce this coagulation, while in other cases it is due to inflammation of the tissues which surround a vein, or laceration of a vein (as when the placenta is expelled from the uterus). A clot thus formed in a vessel increases and extends from one to another, till it reaches and finally fills a large vessel. Clots of this kind occurring in veins have been noticed from the times of Ambrose Pare and Petit, who seem to have been the first to apply the term thrombus to them. THRONDHJEM, or Trojidhjem (Ger.
